### QUALIFICATIONS

- 1. The applicant must be a current junior, senior or graduate full-time student by credit hours from one of the eligible universities listed above.
- 2. A cumulative G.P.A. of 3.5 or better is required.
- 3. The student must be a current South Florida resident in one of the following counties: Miami-Dade, Broward, Palm Beach, Charlotte, Collier, Desoto, Glades, Hardee, Hendry, Highlands, Lee, Manatee, Martin, Monroe, Okeechobee, Sarasota, or St. Lucie.



## APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Applicant information
  - a. Student Name
  - b. School Name
  - c. Location/Student Address
  - d. Major
  - e. GPA
  - f. Current Credits
  - g. School Year, (Junior, Senior or Graduate)
  - h. Expected Graduation Date
- 2. Latest transcripts (signature and sealed copy are not required).
- 3. A letter of reference from a current or previous professor, instructor, or academic advisor stating reasons for the scholarship recommendation.
- 4. A written scholarship application essay from the applicant explaining their interest in the fields of Governance, Risk Management, Compliance, Audit and Security, as well as their community involvement related to these fields.

# APPLICATION DEADLINE

Applications must be received by **5:00 pm EST on Friday, April 19, 2024**. The scholarship award will formally be announced at the Chapter's Annual General Meeting, and the winner(s) will be notified prior to that date.
